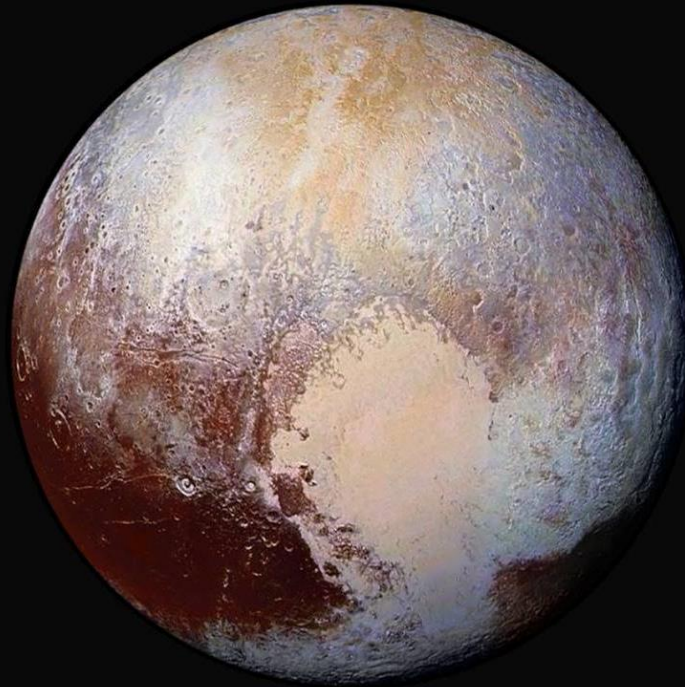


# Images from Space – with technology from Chelmsford
